New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology invites applications for a full-time position of instructor whose primary duty will be to teach courses in Engineering Science that are central to undergraduate engineering programs. In addition to teaching eight courses per academic year, the successful candidate will serve the engineering programs through review and development of courses, recruiting and outreach.

Minimum qualifications are a Master's degree in an engineering discipline (Ph.D. in an engineering discipline preferred), demonstrated commitment to engineering education, record of excellence in teaching, exceptional communication skills in English, and evidence of ability to teach several courses selected from introduction to engineering, computer programming, statistics, fluid mechanics, mechanics of materials, dynamics, engineering economics, circuits, thermodynamics, and heat & mass transfer.

The expected starting date is August 13, 2018 and applications will start to be reviewed on March 1, 2018, but applications will be considered until the position is filled. Applications for the position should include a cover letter that addresses requirements of the position, curriculum vita, teaching evaluations, unofficial transcripts, statement of teaching philosophy, and the names and contact information of at least three references.
