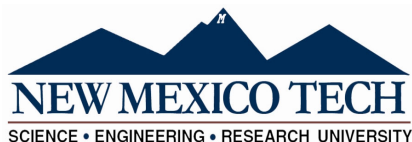

JOB SUMMARY:

The fundamental purpose of this position is to maintain, and repair light, medium, and heavy-duty gasoline/diesel vehicles and equipment in support of PRTC. The Part-Time Mechanic I performs field repairs on a variety of vehicles and equipment and is required to work both indoors and outdoors depending on the equipment and location. The Part-time Mechanic I reports to the Maintenance supervisor for direction and scheduling repairs. This position requires formal training at a trade or technical school in engine repair or diesel engines. The applicant may be required to occasionally travel to the main NM Tech Campus in Socorro for training to perform repairs on fleet vehicles and equipment, or other sites as needed.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

Performs field maintenance, fueling, and repairs on all vehicles, equipment, and components consistent with abilities. 40%

Operates and maintains PRTC's fueling/servicing tanks and pumps in performance of duties. 5%

Performs start, move, and shutdown of all equipment and daily inspections of equipment to determine and report mechanical state. 25%

Uses and operates various field/shop mechanical and power tools normally associated with daily/scheduled repairs and lubrication. 15%

Attends weekly Maintenance meetings and trainings, Acknowledges and abides by sick/annual leave policies, communicates with all essential personnel. Acknowledges and abides by New Mexico Tech/PRTC safety policies/SOP's/ security policies, etc. 15%

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Read and comprehend instructions, write information and complete simple forms. High School (or GED) level ability in spelling, grammar, composition and math. Formal diploma/certificate/degree program of 6-18 months after high school- General Engine Mechanics or Diesel Mechanics. Five (5) years mechanic experience with heavy equipment maintenance and repairs. This position MAY require a Department of Defense security clearance through Secret to be obtained. A valid New Mexico driver's license

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

At least 5 year experience with fleet vehicle repair and maintenance. Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with HazMat endorsement. Trade school or formal mechanical apprenticeship.
