Support Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL) STEM outreach activities at Kirtland AFB that include: teaching DoD STARBASE program classes to 5th grade students 4-5 days per week, preparing materials for STEM outreach activities, assisting with the planning/implementation of culminating events, and representing AFRL at community STEM events. This is a year-round position, 30 -36 hours per week.
