

Application for Senate Bill Proposal

An opportunity for a study abroad with The Green Program was brought to my attention by the mechanical engineering department via an email. I applied and received confirmation that I had been accepted to the trip they make to Nepal in January 2020. The purpose of the program is to give students a chance to study abroad over either winter, spring, or summer break in Japan, Iceland, Nepal, or Peru, specifically in the field of renewable and alternative energy. The Nepal trip specifically will enroll me in classes to study solar micro-grid systems and their practicality, then we will trek to a rural village and plan and install an off-grid solar field to provide energy to the village. The trip is 10 days long, while there, they will provide food, classes, and a place to stay. There are two methods of payment, a one-time \$4300 payment, or a 3-step payment plan totaling \$4700, where \$500 is due initially to reserve my spot, then \$2100 is due three weeks after, then the remaining \$2100 is due 4 weeks before the event. A plane ticket is not included in the total, the cheapest ticket to Nepal and back is \$1600. This brings the total to \$5,900, if I choose the one-time payment option.

I have applied for a minority scholarship that would give \$1500, I will most likely receive this, bringing the total to \$4,400. The Green project also has scholarships, I have applied for them and would receive \$1800. This brings the possible total down to \$2,600. I will also apply for student funding from the Dean of Students Office, in the hope that the SGA and Dean of Students office would half the remaining total. I have also started a GoFundMe page in the case that none of these avenues work. Due to the uncertainty, I am requesting more in the case that The Green Program scholarship does not come to fruition.

For all the aforementioned costs, I am requesting \$2200 for funding to attend The Green Program's trip to Nepal, but any fraction of that total would be of great help and greatly appreciated.
