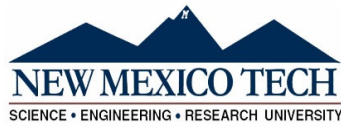

The department offers Master of Science (MSEM) and Professional Master's (MEM) degrees in Engineering Management.
