TY CALDWELL

Founding Presidential Ambassador | Business Management Major
Class of 2026 | New Mexico Tech

Ty Caldwell graduated from New Mexico Tech in May 2026 with a Bachelor of Arts in Business Management and a minor in Economics. Known for his tireless work ethic and passion for leadership, Ty balanced full-time coursework, three jobs, and involvement in several campus organizations during his time at Tech.

Thanks to the generosity of donors who support the Daniel H. López President's Golf Tournament, Ty received a scholarship that allowed him to focus more fully on his education and career goals.

The scholarship opened the door for him to be deeply involved on campus. As one of the founding members of New Mexico Tech's Presidential Ambassador Program, Ty helped establish the program and served as an ambassador from January 2025 through May 2026. In this role, he represented the university at high-profile events and engaged with campus leadership. He credits the experience as invaluable to his academic and personal growth. Nominated for the program by Alumni Affairs Director Sandi Lucero, Ty viewed the role as an opportunity to learn from leaders, build connections, and refine his professional presence.

Athletics were another important part of Ty's life at Tech. He was a dedicated member of the NMT Rugby Team and counts traveling to Nationals in Maryland, where the team placed 8th in the country, among his proudest moments.

"Without the help of this scholarship, I would not have been able to commit to rugby, volleyball, dodgeball, and other student activities that kept me balanced and connected," he says.

In addition, Ty was a regular volunteer at the Daniel H. López President's Golf Tournament. For him, the chance to give back to the very event that made his scholarship possible was both rewarding and inspiring.

"It is amazing to see the community come together at the tournament and know that we are helping future students," he says.

"This scholarship lifted a huge weight off my shoulders. Instead of worrying about how I'm going to pay for school, I was able to put my energy into my classes, leadership roles, and building my future."

Looking ahead, Ty hopes to build a career in restaurant management or take on a leadership role such as district manager for a national company like Discount Tire or Chili's. He also feels strongly about giving back.

"This scholarship has shown me the impact that generosity can have on someone's life," he says. "In the future, I want to be in a position to provide that same kind of support for students who come after me."

To Ty, this scholarship represented more than financial aid. It was a reminder that he was not alone.

"Even if you don't know your future plans, being an ambassador and having this support can help lead you toward them," he says. "Someone always knows someone who is willing to help, and this scholarship proves it."
