Please see the following for updates to the Scope of Work (new/additional text is in red):

15.1 Introduction

The New Mexico Bureau of Geology and Mineral Resources (Bureau), a research and service division of the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology (NMIMT), is seeking qualified contractors to provide subsurface data digitization and interpretation services under an Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity contract.

The Bureau maintains and develops large, multi source subsurface datasets used for geologic mapping, hydrogeologic framework development, applied research, and public service. These datasets originate from public records and lawfully held licensed sources and require professional digitization, compilation, quality control, documentation, and interpretation.

Services will be issued through individual task orders. Each task order will define the specific scope of work, deliverables, schedule, and compensation.

All property developed or acquired by contractors under the contracts resulting from this RFP, including without limitation datasets, compilations, processes, procedures, ideas, electronic files, and other materials, shall be the property of the Bureau. All documents, devices, technologies, or other personal property that form part of contractors' services, or any resulting work product shall be the property of the Bureau. All works of authorship created while providing the services shall be considered works made for hire for the Bureau, and if such works are determined to not be works made for hire, all right, title and interest to such works shall be assigned to the Bureau. All inventions arising as a result of the services shall be reported to the Bureau, and the Bureau shall have the exclusive right to seek protection and enjoy the benefits of such inventions.

Section 15.5 Third Party Data Use

The Bureau may provide access to Bureau held or licensed third party datasets for the limited purpose of performing authorized services. All third-party data shall be treated as confidential and shall not be disclosed for any purpose other than is necessary to perform authorized services.

Contractors shall use such data only for the authorized project, shall not redistribute such data, and shall comply with any licensing restrictions communicated by the Bureau.

Interpretive deliverables may reference derived analyses but shall not include raw third party datasets unless expressly authorized.

15.6 Confidentiality

Any confidential information provided to, or developed by, the contractors in the performance of the contracts resulting from this RFP, including but not limited to trade secrets, proprietary information, intellectual property, and third-party data, shall be kept confidential and shall not be made available to any individual or organization by the contractors without the prior written approval of the Bureau.

Contractors shall certify their ability to safeguard and prevent the inadvertent disclosure of such confidential information.

15.7 Deliverables

Deliverables shall be defined within individual task orders and may include, but are not limited to:

- Depth registered raster images of scanned well logs compatible with commercially available geologic and geophysical interpretation software;
- Curated digital datasets including LAS files and associated metadata;
- Documentation describing sources, methods, assumptions, and limitations; and
- Technical memoranda summarizing methodology and data confidence where requested.
- Deliverables shall be provided electronically in formats specified in the applicable task order.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE RFP REMAIN UNCHANGED.
