***Letter of Addendum***

Commodity: Ordnance Technician Services

Q1: Can the Customer confirm if this work will include more than 1 Ordnance Technician?

A1: The requirement may include up to four (4) Ordnance Technicians, depending on operational needs.

Q2: Period of Performance begins prior to RFP due date of 05/06/2026 @ 2:00 PM (local time). Can the Customer provide clarification on the anticipated start date of this work?

A2: The anticipated start date of May 1, 2026 is preliminary. The actual start date will be adjusted as necessary following contract award.

Q3: Can the Customer confirm if the work will fall under a 1-year Period of Performance? Does Customer anticipate adding additional option periods?

A3: The base Period of Performance is one (1) year. No option periods are identified at this time.

Q4: Will funding be applied to a Cost Reimbursable Travel PO, if applicable?

A4: Travel outside of Socorro, New Mexico will be reimbursed.

Q5: Should pricing submittals include an OT rate, if OT work is performed?

A5: Yes, Offerors should include an overtime (OT) rate in their pricing in the event overtime is approved.

Q6: Is the Customer looking for Military EOD qualified personnel only? If not, what qualifications or certifications are required by the Customer?

A6: Ideally, military EOD qualified personnel are preferred; however, certified bomb technicians or certified explosive blasters will also be accepted.

Q7: What Federal, Industry, and Educational Certifications are required?

A7: The Customer will accept personnel qualified through either military or civilian explosive ordnance training pathways. Military Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) technicians trained through the joint service Naval School Explosive Ordnance Disposal are considered qualified, with experience in military ordnance, improvised explosive devices, and related hazards. Civilian personnel must be certified as Public Safety Bomb Technicians through successful completion of the FBI Hazardous Devices School, including required prerequisites and ongoing recertification. Additional relevant certifications, such as UXO technician training or advanced coursework, are acceptable in demonstrating overall competency.

Q8: Is a SECRET clearance required?

A8: Yes, a SECRET clearance is required.

Q9: Will Customer directed medical clearances and certifications be applied to a Cost Reimbursable PO?

A9: Medical clearances are not required; therefore, this does not apply.

Q10: Is there a specified medical or fitness clearance standard required by the Customer?

A10: No, there is no specified medical or fitness clearance standard required.

Q11: Is only Attachment B required for a Cost Proposal, with no associated cost narrative?

A11: Yes, only Attachment B is required for the Cost Proposal. No additional cost narrative is required unless otherwise specified.
