NOE will provide additional characterization of legacy radioactive materials, will collect additional data, and will prepare and send the items for final disposal. This includes coordination with disposal facilities, transportation contractors, use of specialized equipment, and necessary record keeping.

4. Detailed explanation of criteria developed for this purchase:

Removal of historical radioactive waste, based upon regulatory, safety, and permitting requirements.

5. Provide a detailed, sufficient explanation of the reasons, qualifications or unique capabilities of the prospective vendor that make that prospective vendor the one source for providing the items of tangible property, services, or professional services:

NOE is an expert in the applicable regulatory, safety, and permitting requirements, as well as the specifics of the waste in the connex, because they previously characterized the Connex contents and removed some materials for final disposal.

6. Provide a detailed, sufficient explanation of how the items of tangible property, services, or professional services is/are unique and how this uniqueness is substantially related to the intended purpose of the department/grant:

A new characterization of the contents of the Connex by a different vendor would incur repetitive costs that NMT has already paid for with this vendor.
