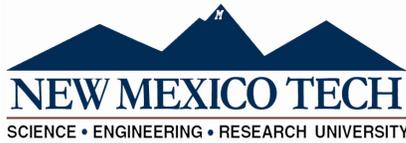

JOB SUMMARY:

The Cyber Kinetic Field Supervisor is responsible for overseeing the preparation, coordination, and management of field site operations to support research, testing, and training activities. This includes supervising personnel, equipment, and vehicles, ensuring compliance with safety protocols, and maintaining field facilities. The supervisor will also be tasked with managing the construction, maintenance, and cleanup of site structures and apparatuses, and coordinating field operations to meet project schedules efficiently and safely.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

Supervises and coordinates support service and field personnel.	25%
Trains and mentors field personnel, establishes training programs as needed.	10%
Prepares test sites to meet engineering, test, research and/or training project specification; cleans test sites after test completion.	25%
Supervises and participates in fabrication, erection, or moving of target structures and construction of field facilities, utilities and buildings.	10%
Inspects work in progress to assure conformance to specification, cost and work completion on schedules.	15%
Assists in coordinating use and maintenance of heavy equipment to meet test schedules.	5%
Participates with test range personnel, in all facets of test set up, equipment operation. Construction, facilities clean up, cutting/welding and other activities.	10%

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

High School (or GED) level ability in spelling, grammar, composition and math. Knowledge and skills related to the operation of heavy equipment, construction, welding, and safety regulations. Ability to communicate clearly and work effectively with a multidisciplinary team. Minimum of 10 years of field experience, including at least four years in a supervisory role. Experience in ordering materials, estimating labor hours, and meeting project deadlines.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Experience with rigging, crane operation (Class II), and welding is preferred. Experience in project management, including budgeting and material/labor estimation.
