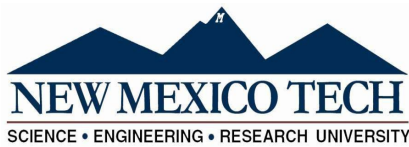

JOB SUMMARY:

Plan, implement and coordinate safety programs for the prevention of or to correct unsafe environmental working conditions. Conducts or coordinates training of the work force concerning safety laws and regulations; use of safety equipment, devices and clothing, and first aid. Inspects facilities, test sites and safety equipment to identify and correct potential hazards; and to ensure compliance with safety regulations. Conducts or directs testing of air quality, noise and temperature to verify compliance with health and safety regulations. Issues and manages the radiation badge program. Maintains liaison with outside organizations such as fire departments, mutual aid departments and rescue teams.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

Organizes and conducts safety inspections throughout EMRTC.

Maintains adequate safety equipment/supplies inventory; issues as needed.

Conducts safety/first aid training in conjunction with the safety program pertaining to everyday activities.

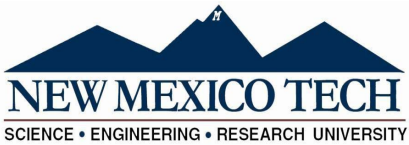
Enforces NMT/EMRTC policies, regulations and established SOP's; and OSHA Regulations.

Maintains records as they pertain to the safety office.
