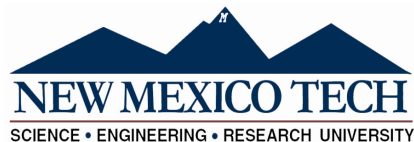

### JOB SUMMARY:

Assists the Director of Golf in all phases of the daily golf course operations. Assist with the Socorro Junior Golf Program and all events/tournaments.

### JOB FUNCTIONS:

Manage golf shop counter

1. Provides excellent customer services, which includes sale of inventory, green fees, memberships, range balls and carts.
2. Responsible for golf course marshalling and ranging duties.
3. Ensures the golf shop is clean and presentable to the public.
4. Reconciles cash register at end of shift and generates golf shop/grill deposits

Teaching

1. Give public group lessons to junior golfers through the New Mexico Tech Golf Course Junior Golf Program and PGA Junior League.
2. Give public lessons to special groups (group outings, ladies groups, physically impaired, classes for elderly, etc.).

Tournament Administration and Preparation

1. Ensures that a list of participants is received before the tournament and enters all participants in to the computer tournament software.
2. Checks in participants for the tournament as they arrive and justifies number of participants to number of entry fees received. Informs participants of the rules and format of play.
3. Prepares tee sheets, scorecards, cart signs, and score-sheets. During play, administers marshaling and helps make decisions on the rules of golf and etiquette. At the end of play, checks for correct scoring and enters/modifies tournament scores in USGA handicap system as needed.

Golf Cart Maintenance and Club Repair

1. Ensures that golf carts brought up at the beginning of the day are clean and in good working condition.

2. If any carts are deemed dangerous, in need of repair, or are in poor working condition, that they are so marked and fixed before the public is allowed to use them.
3. Ensures that at the end of the day, all carts are cleaned and washed to be in good condition for the next day.
4. Perform minor club repairs as needed.

**Inventory Control**

1. Checks inventory in when it arrives.
2. Merchandises inventory on a weekly basis.
3. Performs monthly inventory counts.

High School (or GED) level ability in spelling, grammar, composition and math. Golf Knowledgeable. Extensive golf background. Computer Literate. Golf Teaching Skills. Golf Tournament Administration. Communication skills.
