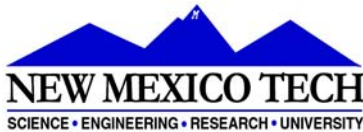

**JOB DUTIES:**

**REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

Bachelor's degree highly desired; equivalent non-degree experience may be accepted. Area of study: Physical sciences and/or environmental management. Basic knowledge of the physical sciences and scientific methods required. Advanced knowledge of cave exploration and working safely in caves and other field environments required. Ability to work with analytical field, laboratory, and computer research equipment required. Ability to communicate well orally and in writing and use of standard professional computer software required.
