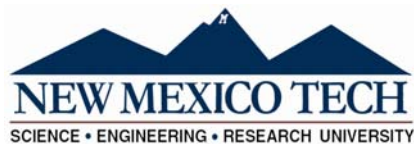

JOB DUTIES:

Conducts, assists with, and facilitates multidisciplinary cave and karst scientific and management research, data collection, plus laboratory, field, and digital analyses. Performs vehicle and other equipment calibration and maintenance as needed to support those activities, and other NCKRI tasks as assigned. This position is stationed at NCKRI's offices in Carlsbad, New Mexico.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree highly desired; equivalent non-degree experience may be accepted. Basic knowledge of the physical sciences and scientific research methods required. Advanced knowledge of cave exploration and working safely in cave and other field environments required. Ability to work with analytical field, laboratory, and computer research equipment required. Ability to communication well orally and in writing with standard professional computer software required. Knowledge and experience with GIS software highly desired.
