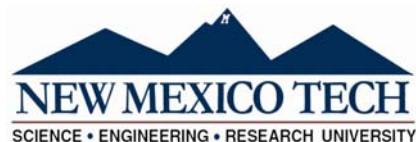

Master's degree required in geoscience with area of study in Argon geochronology or geochemistry of other noble gas systems. Familiarity with the operation of noble gas mass spectrometers required. Mineral separation experience required. Working knowledge of Python desired. Ph.D. in Ar/Ar geochemistry, geochronology, or other noble gas systems desired.
