

Martial Arts Club Bill Proposal

The NMT Martial Arts Club's attendance has been increasing, mostly the Brazilian Jiu Jitsu (BJJ) section, where the men and women of New Mexico Tech are learning how to defend and express themselves through martial arts. Due to the rapidly increased attendance, the members in our club are running out of space to safely practice the sport, which requires us to purchase a new set of mats. With something as intensive as BJJ and the current COVID-19 climate, it would be very beneficial for the club to have another set of mats to train on, avoiding collision during sparring matches and maintaining a safer distance between other athletes. The benefit of getting another set of these high-quality mats don't stop at an increase in practice space, these mats provide a safe surface to practice grappling, wrestling, and judo moves on, which involve an opponent falling onto these mats. With expert coaching, which we have with our newly awarded black belt coach Trent Seelig, we have safely and successfully trained throws, chokes, joint locks, and other techniques; but with more men and women joining, we are quickly losing space, and we have to resort to using thinner, less safe mats in order to accommodate the new participants. The prospect of having these mats also open up a possibility of hosting inter-gym events, which could bring attention to the school, opening up many possibilities for both NMT and our athletes (who are competing across multiple states near New Mexico. Whenever called upon our members are willing to volunteer for any activity with the school or other organizations, unfortunately, our volunteering wasn't logged this and last semester.
