

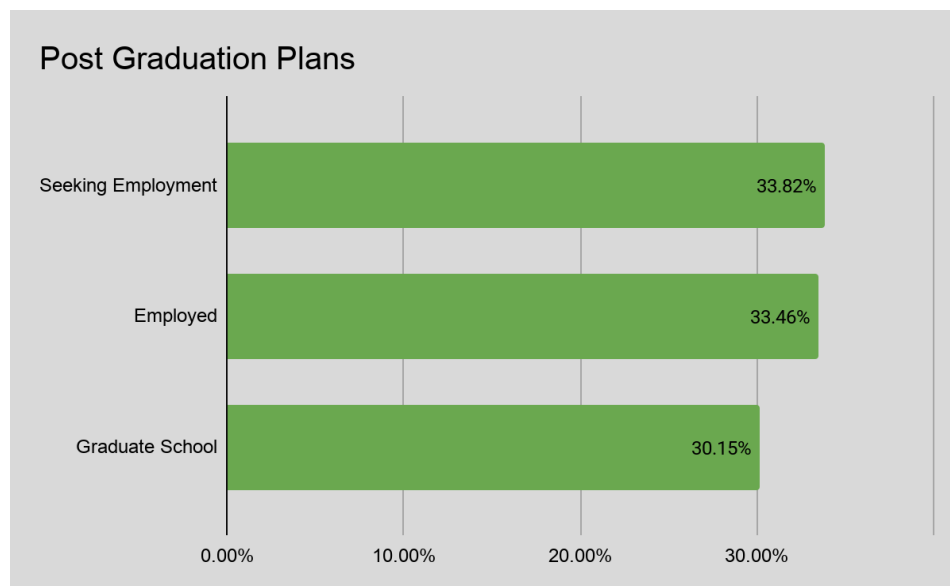


Post Graduation Plans

Fall 2025 - Spring 2026*

Overview

The Fall 2025-Spring 2026 NMT Post Graduation Plans report details that 81.44% of 334 graduates reported their plans just prior to the May 2026 commencement ceremony, with employment (33.82%), education (30.15%), and job searches (33.82%) each accounting for roughly one-third of outcomes. Data indicates Career Services utilization rate of 79.78%, with 64.83% of employed graduates crediting these resources for securing positions. Employers included Dekker, Los Alamos National Laboratory, Honeywell, and Sandia National Laboratories. The report also highlights postgraduate educational destinations and provides a detailed breakdown of outcomes by degree level and academic program.

Post Graduation Plans

I. Degrees Awarded (334)

- 81.44% (272) Reported plans
- 33.46% (91) Reported permanent employment
- 30.15% (82) Planned to continue their education
- 33.82% (92) Seeking employment
- 33.82% (3) Not started looking for a job
- 10.87% (10) of those seeking employment (92) did not utilize Career Services

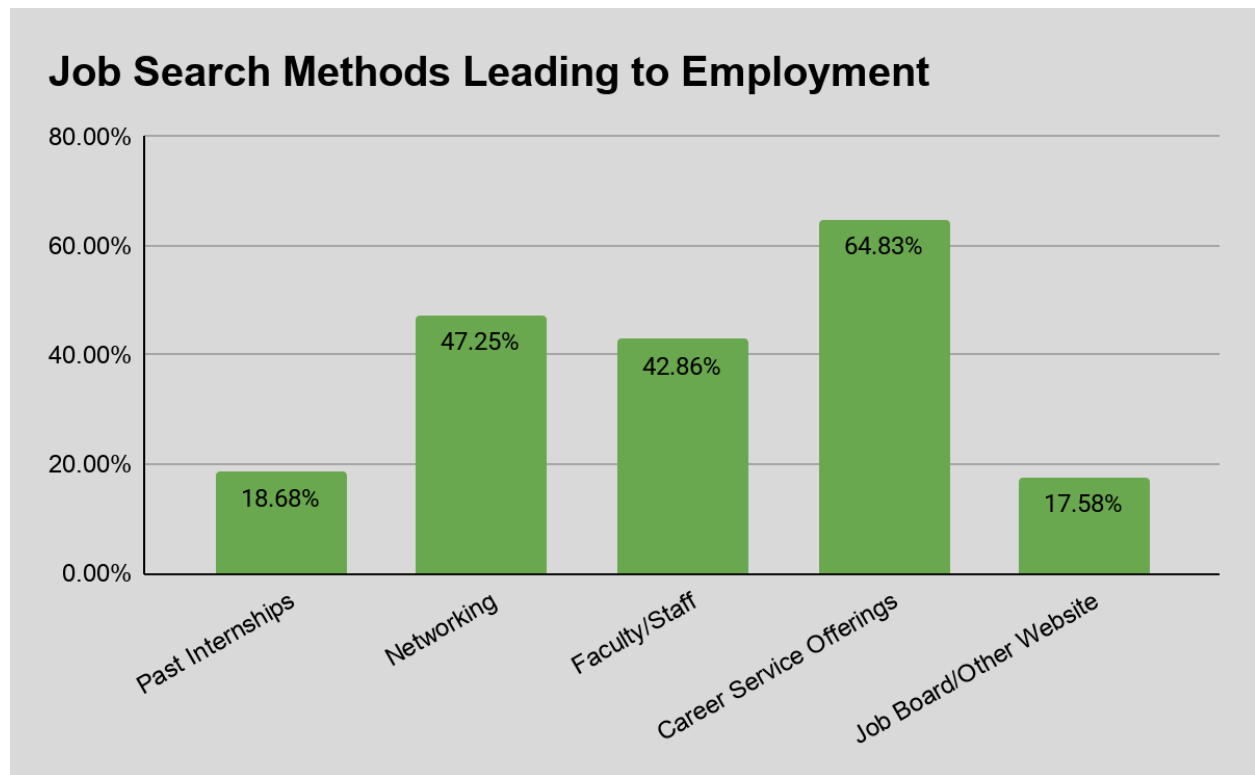

II. Students Using Career Services

- 70.59% (192) Attended a Career Fair
- 33.09% (90) Resume/Cover Letter review
- 26.10% (76) On-campus interview
- 76.10% (207) Used Handshake to look for a job
- 9.92% (27) Attended at least one workshop
- 79.78% (217) Used at least one Career Services offering
- 13.04% (12) of the unemployed (92) and did not use a Career Services offering

III. Job Search Methods Leading to Employment

- 33.46% (91) Reported full-time employment
- 64.83% (59) Career Services offerings led to employment
- 47.25% (43) Networking led to employment
- 17.58% (16) Job board/website led to employment
- 42.86% (39) Faculty/staff recommendation led to employment
- 18.68% (17) Past internships led to employment
