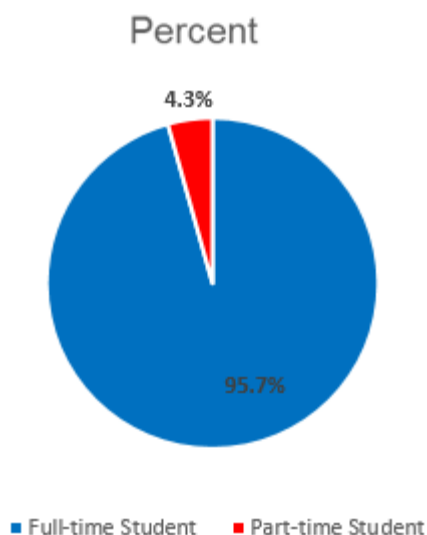

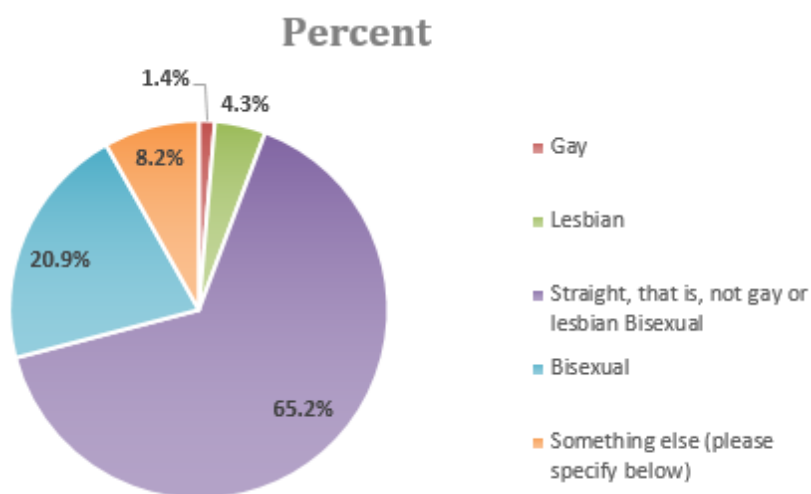

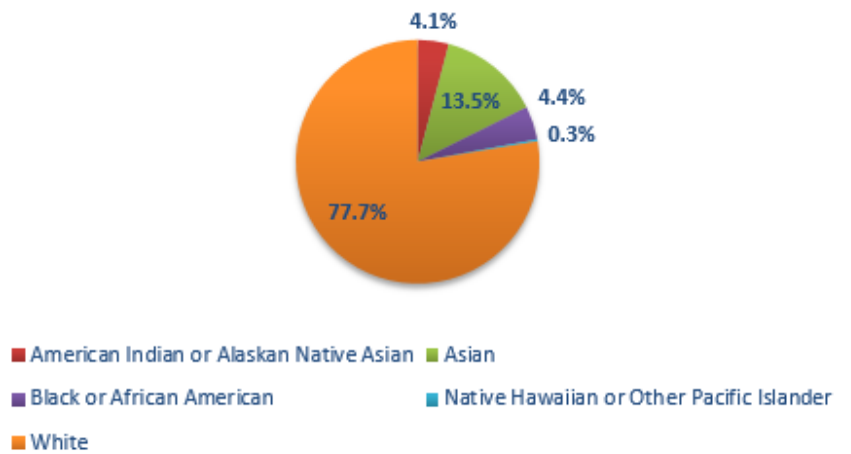

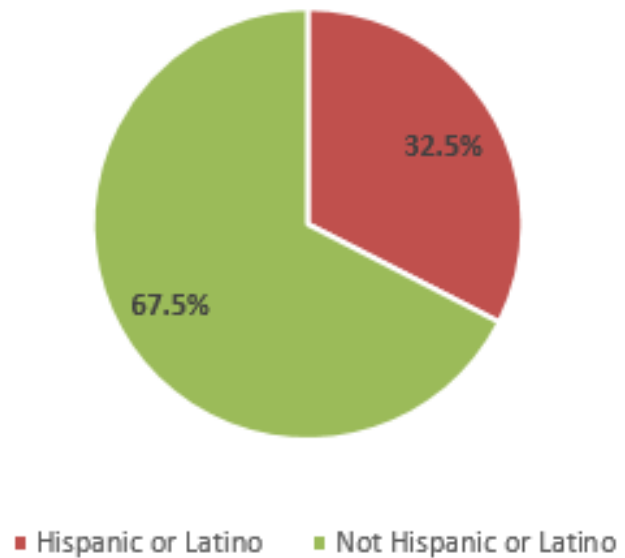

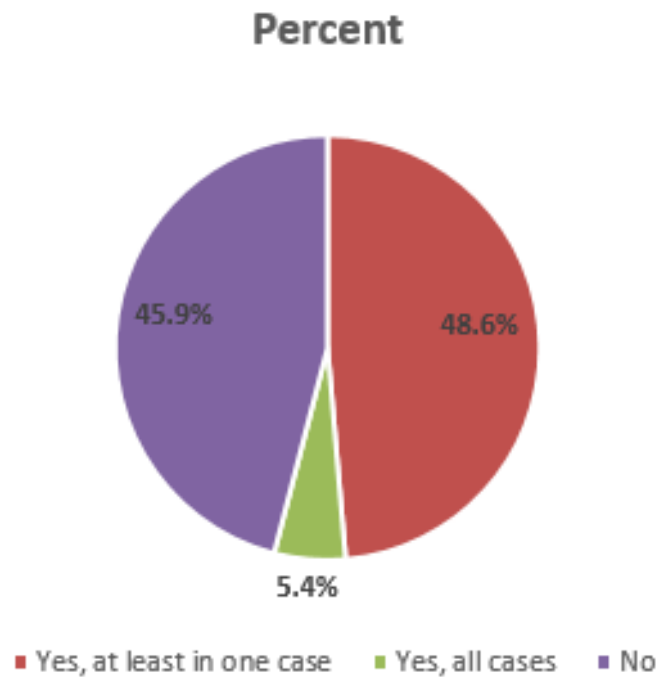

11. In any of the cases you reported above, had the person who had sexually assaulted you or had unwanted sexual contact with you been drinking alcohol or using drugs at the time?



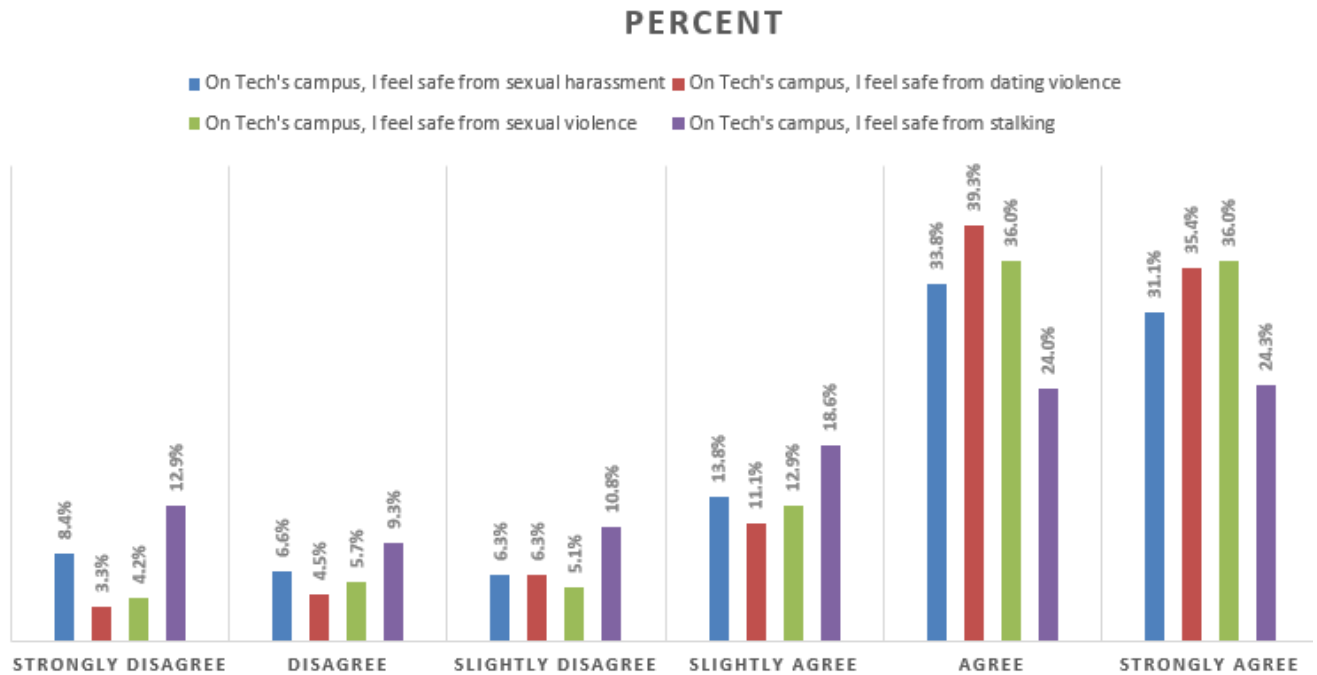
